Cabernet Sauvignon

(Ca-burr-nay-SO-vin-yawn) The king of red wines; makes the great red Bordeaux wines of France, and among the finest reds in California, Chile and Australia; full-bodied with rich currant flavors, but can be somewhat rough (tannic) when young; best with simply prepared beef and lamb dishes. Cabernets are almost always aged in oak for over a year, and should age several more years in the bottle. The great Cabernets of the Medoc region in France age for 15 years and more.

Pinot Noir

(PEE-know Na WAHR): Makes the great reds of Burgundy in France, and good wines from California and Oregon; more delicate than Cabernet or Merlot, with strawberry and tea-leaf aromas and flavors; excellent with grilled salmon, roast chicken and grilled lamb. Pinots can be high alcohol, light in color and low in tannin, though oak aging can increase the tannin levels.

Syrah/ Shirah and Petite Sirah

Sah-RAH/Shur-az) A hearty, spicy red that excels in France's Rhone Valley, California and Australia Where it's known as Shiraz; wonderfully wild blackfruit aromas and flavors, with overtones of black pepper spice and roasting meat; great with steak, beef, wild game, stews, etc. Like California Zinfandels American Syrahs can be full (-bodied wines but often show more spice elements and less berry-like fruit than zins.

Zinfandel

(ZIN-fan-dell) California's native red and perhaps the world's most versatile wine grape, making everything from blush wine (White Zinfandel) to light, Beaujolais-style reds, rich, heavy reds, and even ports; has a zesty, berryish flavor that is perfect for tomato-sauce pastas, pizza, and grilled and BBQ's meats. Zinfandels are drinkable now but will certainly not wilt in the cellar.

Meritage & Proprietary Blends

Meritage: Those wines that are often referred to as reserve bottlings, as selections, as proprietary names (such as Opus or Insignia. Wineries the world over are following the Bordeaux-established style of blending Cabernet Sauvignon with merlot (and sometimes a little Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot) to create a more complex wine. These Cabernet/Merlot blends are frequently the producer's finest bottlings.

Merlot

(mare-LOW) Similar to Cabernet, but softer and fruitier, with cherry-like flavors and hints of tobacco and mint; the current fav-rave among novice wine consumers, because it's easy to drink and pronounce. Merlots are often less tannic and more lush than Cabernets, though still full-bodied, deep in color and fairly high in alcohol with flavors fo cherry, plum, and chocolate.
